# 13 DAY TRAVEL ITINERARY

## JORDAN, HOLY LAND & ITALY

### DAY 01 MIAMI / ISTANBUL

We depart Miami on Turkish Airlines to Istanbul.

### DAY 02 ISTANBUL / AMMAN

Arrive Istanbul and change planes to Amman. Upon arrival in Amman, we will be met by our escorts and travel to our hotel in Amman for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 03 MT. NEBO / PETRA

Drive to Mt. Nebo to see the place where Moses viewed the Promise Land, died, and was buried. Next visit Masada to see the 4th century mosaic floor map of Jerusalem at the time of Jesus. Continue to Petra for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 04 PETRA / AMMAN

Today you will tour Petra, correctly called the "eighth wonder of the world." This entire city of rose-colored temples and amphitheatres is carved from the multi-hued rock cliffs which surround its hidden valley. From this city came the family of Herod the Great who slaughtered the infants of Bethlehem. You enter the city through a narrow passage, surrounded by colorful and beautiful 300 ft cliffs, and at the end of the Siq, you will see the impressive Treasury, hewn out of the solid rock from the side of the mountain, and it is about 140 feet high and 90 feet wide. See the Amphitheatre, city center, and the Monastery. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight in Amman.

### DAY 05 JERASH / JERUSALEM

Depart Petra by bus to Jerash, the "CITY OF DECAPOLIS", known as the Pompeii of the East for its extraordinary state of preservation, and along the way cross River Jabbok where Jacob wrestled with the angel, and changed his name from Jacob to Israel. View the mountains of Gilead and continue to Jerash, one of the largest and most preserved Roman cities, and where Christ did cast the demons. As you approach the city, visitors are greeted by the imposing triple-arched gateway, built to honor the Emperor Hadrian's arrival at Jerash in A.D. 129. Visit the Byzantine churches, the Roman Amphitheatre, and the Street of Columns, where the Chariots used to race. It is believed that Paul travelled through this city on his way to Damascus. Later on, transfer to the border and cross to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 06 JERUSALEM: THE HOLY CITY AND BETHLEHEM THE NATIVITY / MT. OLIVES / CHURCH OF VISITATION / SHEPHERD'S FIELD / CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY

On the first day in Jerusalem we present an overview for a better understanding of its geography and some of the key sites surrounding the area. This includes a dramatic view of the Old City from the Mount of Olives, revealing a city with 4000 years of history. From this vantage point see much of what makes Jerusalem such a unique city to the three major religions – Judaism, Christianity and Islam. We then head to the village of Ein Karem, the birthplace of St John the Baptist and to the Church of Visitation where the Blessed Virgin Mary visited her cousin, Elizabeth, and proclaimed the 'Magnificat'. In the afternoon we drive to the Shepherd's Fields where the angels announced the birth of Jesus. Then we visit the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem that stands upon the site where Jesus was born. Mass in Bethlehem or the Shepherds Fields. This evening we will make the Traditional Pilgrims Solemn Entry into the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

### DAY 07 STATIONS OF THE CROSS / CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHRE / ST. ANNE'S CHURCH / ECCE HOMO / WAILING WALL / UPPER ROOM / DORMITION

Early in the morning we retrace the last steps of Jesus. As we walk along the Via Dolorosa (Way of Sorrow), through the markets of the Old City praying the Stations of the Cross, we reflect on the greatness of His sacrifice. Finally we arrive at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre for Mass. After breakfast at our hotel we return to the Old City of Jerusalem to visit St. Anne's Church, the home of the Virgin Mary and her parents Saints Joachim and Anne. We pass the Ecce Homo where Pilate proclaimed "Behold the man"; then the Wailing Wall, the most holy place for Jews. Nearby is the Dome of the Rock and the Haram al Sharif or Temple Mount. We exit at Mt Zion. At the Cenacle we visit the Upper Room of the Last Supper. Next we go to Dormition Abbey where we believe the Blessed Mary died. We end the day at St. Peter in Gallicantu where Peter denied Him thrice. We plan to have an audience this afternoon with His Beatitude, the Latin Patriarch of Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem.



## DAY 08 TEL AVIV / ROME / SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

This morning, board your flight from Tel Aviv to Rome. Upon arrival in Rome, you will depart to San Giovanni Rotondo, and you will have a tour to include the old church and see the crucifix from which Saint Pio received the stigmata in 1918. See Santa Croche, and the Tomb of Saint Pio. Then visit St. Michael's Cave "Monte San Angelo", where 6 Popes have knelt in prayer here, seeking the protection of St. Michael. Return to San Giovanni Rotondo for dinner and overnight. **Mass at OUR LADY OF GRACE Church. Padre Pio.**

## DAY 09 MONTE CASSINO / POMPEII / SORRENTO

Depart San Giovanni Rotondo and travel to Monte Cassino, and see the Abbey of Monte Cassino, where the Benedictine Order was founded by St. Benedict, and have **Mass at the Abbey**. Continue to Pompeii, which was destroyed by the ashes of Mt. Vesuvius in AD 79. Marvel at the Lost City of Pompeii, a place not much changed in the last 2,000 years. Visit the excavations and beautiful Rosary Basilica. Continue to Sorrento for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 10 SORRENTO / ISLE OF CAPRI

This is the most spectacular scenery as you drive along the coastline with rugged cliffs and a breathtaking view of the Mediterranean Sea. Take a boat to the Isle of Capri and see the Blue Grotto, a dark cavern where the sea glows electric blue. **After Mass in Sorrento**, return to your hotel for dinner and overnight in Sorrento.

## DAY 11 NAPLES

Leave Sorrento and travel to Naples, Italy's southern beauty! You will be touring palaces, narrow streets, and ancient churches. **See Naples Cathedral; where you will have Mass**, and the lavish Royal Palace and the Castle Nuovo, a 13th century castle. Continue to see the Basilica Santa Restituta, with excellent ceiling frescoes, then onto visit the Gothic Santa Maria Donnaregina, the Baroque Churches of San Filippo Neri, and the San Paolo Maggiore. On to your hotel for dinner and overnight in Naples.

## DAY 12 AMALFI COAST DRIVE & RAVELLO

One of Europe's most spectacular coastlines, the Amalfi Coast rewards with jaw-dropping views at every turn. Experience daily life here as you visit Amalfi on the shoreline and travel up to beautiful Ravello soaring between the sky and cliffs. **Mass at St. William Catholic Church in Sorrento** and continue to Villa Rufolo and wander through the gardens that inspired Wagner's ode to a magic garden in the opera Parsifal, and savor homemade pasta at a legendary four-generation family restaurant. Overnight in Naples.

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

## The Tour Price Includes:

**Air Transportation:** Airfare is based on special contract agreements with various international airlines and include certain restrictions and deadlines. These fares are subject to cancellation penalties, and once tickets are issued, they are **NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE AND CANNOT BE USED TOWARDS FUTURE TRAVEL**. Please refer to our CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY below. Airfare and tour prices are based on prices effective as of **JANUARY 1, 2023** and are subject to change without notice.

**Surface/Land Transportation:** All surface/land transportation described in the itinerary will be provided by modern motor coach, designed for highway travel. Groups will be met and transferred upon arrival and departure.

**Hotels:** We only use first-class hotels. Hotel accommodations are based on double occupancy (2 per room). We reserve the right to substitute hotels of similar quality for those specified in the itinerary.

**Single Room Supplements:** If you would like a single room, there is an additional cost of **\$1,200.00** that will be added to the tour price. Single rooms are limited and will be reserved on a first come first serve basis. If you request a roommate and none is available, you will be considered a "forced single," and charged one half (½) of the Single Room Supplement cost.

**Meal Plan:** Meal plans include two (2) meals per day, breakfast and dinner, with timing depending on the itinerary. Taxes and service charges normally appearing on restaurant bills are included in the tour price for these meals. **A list of any and all dietary requests or food allergies must be emailed to [cathy@inspirationaltoursinc.com](mailto:cathy@inspirationaltoursinc.com) for hotel/airline accommodation at least seven (7) days before departure.** We cannot guarantee any dietary accommodations but will make all efforts to secure special dietary requests. In the event airlines or hotels are unable to accommodate dietary requests, you will be responsible for your meals; it is the individual's responsibility to choose appropriate foods while on the tour. Unused meals will NOT be reimbursed.

**Baggage:** Inspirational Tours, Inc. restricts all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage (max. 50 lbs.) and one (1) carry-on (max. 18 lbs.). **All passengers should check with the airline for up-to-date baggage weight/dimension information and restrictions, which are subject to change at any time before departure.**

**Airport Taxes and Fuel Surcharges:** are included in the tour price and are subject to change.

**Tips On The Tour:** Tips to guides, porters, headwaiters, and drivers are included in the tour price, unless otherwise specified.

**The Tour Price Does Not Include:** Expenses related to issuance/renewal of passports, laundry, mineral waters, wine & liquor, after-lunch/dinner tea, coffee, or food not included in the meal plan above; additional baggage; expenses of carriages, guides, sightseeing or other services other than those specifically mentioned as included in the itinerary; insurance for baggage or personal trip or health insurance; all items of a personal nature, in addition to those not listed above as being included in the tour price.

**Booking Conditions: Deposits and Payment:** **A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person**, payable via cash, check or money order, is required at the time of registration. No registration will be processed without a deposit. Invoices for final balances are issued at or near 90 days before departure. Full and final payment is due 60 days before departure. Registrations received within 90 days of departure require payment in full. If there is any outstanding balance by the Final Payment due date listed on your invoice, all travel services will be subject to automatic cancellation and cancellation fees will apply. A service reinstatement fee may be added to your invoice and must be paid in advance in order to apply for reconfirmation of services. **WE ONLY ACCEPT CASH, CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS FOR THE REGISTRATION FEE.** Payment by credit card is accepted ONLY for final balances or payments towards final balances; all credit card payments will be assessed a **3% non-refundable** convenience fee, which will be added to the total amount being charged.

**Cancellations and Refund Policy:** All cancellations **MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING VIA FAX, E-MAIL OR U.S. MAIL**. The date of the cancellation request is the date used for purposes of any assessed cancellation fees. **Please note that the deposit is NON-REFUNDABLE as stated on the Registration Form.** Cancellation fees (as to any monies paid over the deposit for a tour with a non-refundable deposit) depend on the timing of the cancellation request, and are as follows: request received between time of registration and up to 90 days prior to departure—automatic \$100.00 cancellation fee; request received within 89 to 60 days prior to departure—automatic \$300.00 cancellation fee; request received within 59 to 30 days prior to departure—cancellation fee of **50%** of tour cost; request received 29 days or less prior to departure through date of departure—assessed **100%** of the tour cost (air and land, and any deviation fees) as the cancellation fee. Additional charges/fees for deviations and/or upgraded seats may require full payment at time of booking/confirmation, and may be non-refundable; **if a non-refundable air ticket has been issued prior to receiving notice of a cancellation request, you will be 100% responsible for those fees, in addition to the cancellation penalties listed above.** Package cancellation fees include airfare. Once airfare is purchased, either at time of booking, including but not limited to, deviations or seat upgrade requests, or at time of full payment, airline tickets will be issued and are always subject to a 100% penalty. Once full payment is received, Inspirational Tours, Inc. will issue airline tickets, which are non-refundable. Validity date on passports must be for at least six (6) months after the date of return of the tour as per the tour dates, or any deviation request.** If we do not receive a copy of your current passport, the information you provide on your Registration Form will be used for ticketing purposes. If ANY information provided (name, date of birth, etc.) does not match what is on your passport, you may be subject to penalties or fees for corrections to airline tickets, and/or may be denied boarding by the airline. Any name change, including minor spelling corrections, may require reservations to be canceled and re-booked. Reservations will then be subject to availability and pricing at the time of re-booking; any increase in airfare will be borne by the passenger.
